
#### **EXPO ACTIVITIES**



#### **EXHIBIT JUDGING**

A panel of three APS-accredited judges will be evaluating the exhibits based on guidelines delineated in the *APS' Manual of Philatelic Judging*. The guidelines include coverage of the subject, rarity, condition, presentation, relevance of the material, evidence of research, variety of material and so forth, with some criteria varying according to the type of exhibit. The panel's decisions are final in all respects. The distinguished jury for the 2018 Mid-Cities Stamp Expo is:

William A. Fort III, Fairfax, VA. Mr. Fort has been an accredited APS judge since 2012. His specialties are Airmail, British North America, Latin America, United States, US Postal History.

Patrick A. Walters, ARVADA, CO. Mr. Walters has been an accredited APS judge since 1987. He is also an accredited APS literature and Chief Judge. He is currently the United States FISA representative for aero philately and serves on the Plymouth and Sarasota WSP show committees. He is currently a member of 12 stamp societies and was the recent Government Flight section editor for the American Airmail Catalog. In addition to several aero philatelic exhibits, he has exhibited Germany, Philippines, Kansas and Nebraska overprints, and Western Territorials. He is a retired CEO / President of a major pharmaceutical company. His specialties are Aerophilately, Europe, German Area, Postal History and U.S. and Possessions.

Jeffery N. Shapiro, Fayville, MA. Mr. Shapiro has been a certified APS judge since February 29, 2000. He has been collecting stamps since 1955 but began specializing in Twentieth Century postal history about 25 years ago. He has been exhibiting for almost as long. He has been a member of APS since 1984. Besides leadership roles in numerous local and national philatelic organizations, Mr. Shapiro is a Vice-President of the APS. Now retired from a career in social service management, he devotes as much time as he can to philatelic writing, lecturing and mentoring. His collecting interests are Aerophilately, Germany, Modern Philately, Post Cards and U.S. Postal History.
